"There are aircraft in the midsize and legacy general aviation fleet – including aircraft such as the Piper Navajo and comparable Cessna models – whose owners have wanted a modern autopilot option but have had very few choices available to them."

The dealership also complements YAS's existing Garmin avionics capabilities rather than replacing them.

"Garmin continues to be an important part of what we offer, but no single manufacturer has a solution for every aircraft," Gallegos said. "Adding Innovative Aerosystems gives us another avenue to find the right solution for the aircraft and the customer."

Innovative Aerosystems is investing not only in modern flight control systems but also in the continued support and modernization of established avionics products. The company



has acquired rights and assets associated with a number of legacy navigation and communication products, including the widely installed KX 155 family, with the objective of improving long-term product support and developing modernization opportunities.

For YAS, that commitment to supporting both current technology and the existing aircraft fleet was an important reason for establishing the relationship.

“There is a very large fleet of good aircraft still flying with avionics that owners would like to maintain or selectively modernize,” said **Cheryl Denesowych, Director of Operations and Business Development at Yorkton Aircraft Service**. “We like Innovative Aerosystems’ approach because they recognize that market. It is not always about replacing an entire panel. Sometimes the best solution is keeping a proven aircraft viable and giving the owner a practical path forward.”
